

NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Sealed proposals will be received by the Clerk of the Board of County Commissioners at the COMMISSIONER'S OFFICE IN THE COURTHOUSE BUILDING, STEVENSON, WASHINGTON until 4:00 o'clock p.m. on Wednesday, July 15, 2009 for performing the work described below. Sealed proposals received will be opened and publicly read aloud on Thursday, July 16, 2009 at 10:00 o'clock a.m. or shortly thereafter in the PUBLIC WORKS OFFICE IN THE ANNEX BUILDING, STEVENSON, WASHINGTON. Bids received after 4:00 o'clock p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2009 will not be considered.

Project Title - Rock Creek Material Haul Project
Contract No.- 2009-26

Project Description: The improvements consist of loading and hauling of a portion of the debris stockpile from the site near Rock Creek, located in Stevenson Washington, to a stockpile at Home Valley Pit at Home Valley Washington. The material consists of accreted sediment dredged from Rock Creek and placed in an upland stockpile site adjacent to Rock Creek. The material moved will be measured as 95,313 cubic yards of loose material using a Load Ticket System. Round trip is estimated as 14.26 miles. Contract work will include surveying of Rock Creek site to final grade per site plans, surveying and placement of material at Home Valley Pit per stockpile plans, and final site cleanup. Hauling equipment capacity will be pre-measured for loads struck off level. The Contractor will provide a Traffic Control Supervisor and a minimum of 3 Flaggers for the duration of the haul operation.

Bid proposals shall be accompanied by a proposal guarantee in an amount of five percent (5%) of the total bid, based upon the approximate estimate of quantities. All such amounts are subject to forfeiture, in accordance with RCW 47.28.100, if successful bidder fails to enter into contract and bond.

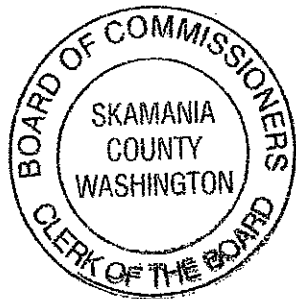
