

SUMMER LABOR
PAY \$10.88

Skamania County has approximately 20 openings for summer labor positions. This is part of a program initiated by the Board of Commissioners to assist persons in achieving higher education and meet increased county work loads. Each position will be filled for a period not to exceed 520 hours and shall be available during the months of May, June, July, August and September, 2008.

These positions will provide backup to the Buildings and Grounds crew, Road Department crew, Parks and Recreation, and a Noxious Weed crew and office help in the Sheriff, Auditor's, Counseling, and Public Works Departments. Duties may include cleaning and maintenance of county facilities and grounds, flagging for county roadwork, working with youth recreational programs, and identifying and eradication of noxious weeds and office work. Other work as required. Assignments may involve operation of hand and power tools and light trucks.

Qualifications:

Must be 18 years of age or older with proof of acceptance or enrollment in a college, university, trade school or other institute of higher learning. Most positions require possession of a valid Driver's license at time of hire, a good driving record and the ability to perform heavy manual labor for extended periods of time in all weather conditions. Pre-employment physical will be required. **Skamania County residents will be given preference.** No persons may be hired for more than two years under this program.
