Attachment to Right-of-Way Use Permit for No Spray Areas:

1. Property Owner shall keep all vegetation away from the traveled roadway.

This will include, but is not limited to:

- a. All plant species listed on the Washington State noxious weeds list.
 - b. All tree limbs shall be cut up to a height of 21 feet off of the roadway surface, to be measured at the outside edge of the shoulder.
 - c. Brush within the R/W shall be maintained to a height of no more than 24 inches high. Brush outside of the R/W shall not lean over and hang into the traveled way.
 - d. Do not allow grass to grow on the shoulder area. This area shall be kept clear of all vegetation at all times.
2. Permit is valid for one year only. A new permit shall be requested in writing by the property owner and issued by Skamania County Department of Public Works each year prior to March 1. All permits will expire on this date. Renewals will be updated with a written request stating that all information is the same and no changes are required. An annual addendum will be attached to the original permit. Any changes from the original R/W Use Permit, shall be submitted as a new application.
 3. If the property owner does not maintain the R/W according to the permit specifications, the owner will be notified in writing of the infraction and given one month to take care of the required maintenance. If, in Skamania County's opinion, the maintenance is not being done, we will cancel the permit, take over maintenance and bill the property owner for costs above that of which herbicide application would have cost. **Permits will not be re-issued from this point on.**
