

Skamania County Commissioner's Policy for Evacuees of the Eagle Creek Fire

Welcome to Skamania County's campground for Eagle Creek fire evacuees. We are happy to provide a safe shelter at no charge to those impacted by the current crisis.

Documented evacuees from the Eagle Creek fire living in the areas of Cascade Locks, Wyeth and Dodson/Warrendale whose homes are in an Evacuation Level Two or Level Three, will be provided space for camping or trailer/motor-homes at the Skamania County Fairgrounds at no charge. Unfortunately, the County is unable to provide food services.

Your specific site location will be assigned by county personnel.

Evacuees are considered those members of the immediate household. Visitors requiring overnight space will be charged the current County rates.

Outdoor smoking and open fires are prohibited. Gas grills are allowed.

Small pets are allowed and it's the owners' responsibility to care for and clean-up after them. Pets causing nuisances will need to be cared for elsewhere at the owners' expense. There may be a local pet shelter available depending on the number of volunteers.

When the Evacuation Level drops to Level One, evacuees will have two days at no charge before returning to their homes.

We realize this is a time of considerable mental and emotional stress for everyone and ask that you be respectful and know we are all in this together.

This policy will be reviewed on October 3rd.
