WHEREAS, the members of the law enforcement agencies of Skamania County play an essential role in safeguarding the rights and freedoms of Skamania County; and



WHEREAS, the men and women of the law enforcement agencies of Skamania County unceasingly provide a vital public service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, we, the Board of Commissioners of Skamania County, Washington, call upon all citizens of Skamania County and upon all patriotic, civic and educational organizations to observe the week of May 12th-18th, 2019 as National Police Week with appropriate ceremonies and observances in which all our people may join in commemorating law enforcement officers, past and present, who, by their faithful and loyal devotion to their responsibilities, have rendered a dedicated service to their communities and, in so doing, have established themselves an enviable and enduring reputation for preserving the rights and security of all citizens.
