## **Wind River Business Park Advisory Committee**

### **Background**

The County of Skamania owns 184 acres +/- which includes improvements such as residential and commercial/industrial buildings in Stabler WA. The County is also in negotiations with the US Forest Service to convey unused USFS properties (another 200 acres +/-) for the purpose of economic development, recreation, historic, research, education and more.

The County Board of Commissioners wishes to establish a community advisory committee to study review and provide comments on future development at the Wind River Old Nursery and US Forest Service complexes (aka “Wind River Business Park”).

### **Advisory Committee**

The committee will be comprised of seven (7) individuals appointed by the Board of Commissioners and representative of the following:

1. One Community member from Stabler
2. One Community member from Carson
3. One Community member “at large”
4. One County Commissioner
5. The County Public Works Director
6. One Port of Skamania Commissioner
7. The Port of Skamania County Manager

**Applications are due by May 17, 2017 by 5:00 pm.**

### **Qualification requirements for interested community members:**

1. Must be at least 18 years of age, have reliable transportation, a county resident (“at large” position) and/or a resident of one of the following: Carson, Stabler (local community member).
2. Individuals must be willing to serve for at least a one year term and to attend a minimum of one meeting per quarter for a total of 4 meetings per year. There may be additional meetings as needed. This is a time commitment by the volunteer in support of the county’s financial future.
3. The County is seeking an open minded and forward thinking individual(s) with a positive and fully constructive attitude towards economic development.
4. Individuals must fully complete and submit the application form by May 17, 2017.
5. The Board of Commissioners may appoint members based on the information submitted in the application form. Additional information may be requested by the County.
