Tips to SAVE money!!

- **Bring loads over 40 lbs.**
- **Try not to dump under 40 lbs a trip - you will pay almost double the rate.**
- **Keep it dry; water is very heavy at 8 lbs a gallon.**
- **Recycle – It could save you well over 50% of your dump cost each month.**
- **Compost – Food and yard waste are very heavy due to their water content. Composting will save you money and produce an environmentally good soil amendment.**
