Skamania County Reminds Residents of Local Candidate Filing

The Skamania County Auditor's Office today reminded residents that the official candidate filing period for 2020 is quickly approaching. Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, the Auditor's Office strongly encourages candidates to file online at www.skamaniacounty.org/elections. Online filing will be available beginning at 9:00 A.M. on May 11th through 4:00 P.M. on May 15th. Residents who wish to file in the Auditor's Office can do so daily from 7:30am – 5:30pm, Monday through Friday May 11th through May 15th by using a drop box available in the public access area of the courthouse. Mailed declarations will be accepted April 27th through May 15th.

Positions open for local filing include two county commissioner positions and a PUD commissioner position, in addition to Precinct Committee Officer positions. We ask that citizens interested in filing for elected office be aware of filing deadlines and requirements for the office that they are interested in.

Additional information on positions open for filing and applicable filing fees is available at the Auditor's Office located at 240 NW Vancouver Ave, Room 27, in Stevenson, or online at www.skamaniacounty.org/elections.

Filing fees are due at the time of filing. The Auditor's Office can accept cash, checks, or credit cards. Filing fees for candidates filing online must be received in the Auditor's Office no later than 5:30 p.m. on May 15th.
