GORGE WEST END TRANSIT - WET

Open to the general public.

Unaccompanied passengers under the age of 12 must have adult call for pre-authorization to ride.

Travels between Carson and Fisher's Landing Transit Center in Clark County - intersection of SE 164th Ave and SE Cascade Park Dr North of SR 14.

Allows linkage with C-TRAN to access the Portland - Vancouver metro area.

For service to or from a location other than a scheduled stop and within 3/4 mile of the scheduled stops within Skamania County. Call Senior Services (509-427-3990) at least one day before your trip to have the bus pick you up at the curb of a specific location. The bus will

pick you up or drop you off as it runs on its schedule between its designated stops.

The bus will deviate up to 3/4 mile off Wind River Hwy or SR 14 to accommodate persons with disabilities. Requests must be made one day in advance. Those needing disabled service at Fisher's Landing must call C-TRAN at (360)695-8918.
