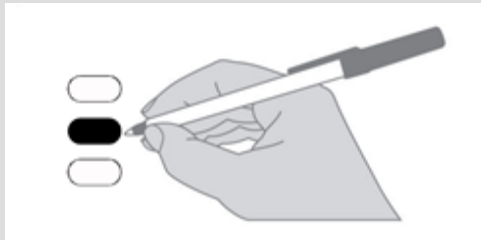

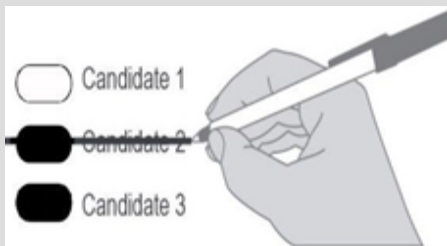
How to vote

Vote for one in each race. If you vote for more than one, no votes will be counted for that race.

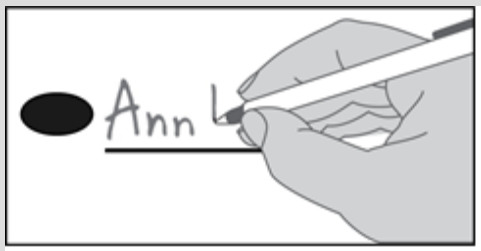
How to correct a mistake

<p style="text-align: center;">Cemetery District Proposition No. 1 Property Tax Levy Lid Lift for Maintenance and Upkeep Costs</p> <p>The Board of Commissioners for the Skamania County Cemetery District adopted Resolution No. 2025-04 Proposing an increase in the District's regular property tax levy. If approved, this proposition would establish a new regular levy rate of \$0.1037 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation to be collected beginning January 2026. This permanent increase will establish a new dollar amount for the purpose of computing the limitations imposed by RCW 84.55.010 for subsequent levies.
